*The Cape Cod Chamber Music Festival, founded by the late collaborative pianist Samuel Sanders and now in its 36th year, presents the finest classical music and contemporary chamber music by world-class musicians and exceptional young artists. Our artistic directors, clarinetist Jon Manasse and pianist Jon Nakamatsu, follow in the footsteps of Nicholas Kitchen, first violin of the Borromeo String Quartet; pianist Brian Zeger; pianist Margo Garrett; and founder Samuel Sanders.*

*The Festival offers four weeks of intensive chamber music programming at various Cape locations in August; spring and fall concerts on the Cape; and special events in New York, as well as expanded residencies in Cape schools. Joshua Bell, Andrés Díaz, Yo-Yo Ma, the Borromeo String Quartet and the Eroica Trio appeared with us early in their careers, long before they became the internationally renowned performers they are today. The Festival also commissions new works and introduces contemporary composers to Cape audiences.*

*Hailed by the New York Times as a “triumph of quality,” the Festival has gained a national reputation and plays a major role in the year-round cultural life of Cape Cod.*
